In pursuance of the orders already passed, the proposed scheme of administration is stated to have been published on 14.8.2017. A copy of the proposed scheme for management of the public trust has been placed on record alongwith C.M. Application No. 8485 of 2017. The proposed scheme has also been uploaded on Mandir's website and information thereof was published in daily newspapers of wide circulation in district Lucknow, namely, Times of India, Dainik Jagran and Rashtriya Sahara.

Due publicity of the scheme of administration does appear to have been done but suggestions from any devotee belonging to Hindu religion have not been received except for an application for modification of the order passed by this Court wherein some objections with respect to management of the trust have been made which are strongly opposed for showing undue interest.

A public charitable trust, needless to say, must have a scheme of administration so that the management of the affairs of the trust is well regulated and there are no complaints from any devotee in this regard. The management committee established under the judgement rendered in the year 1920 has since lost its succession, therefore, the matter has come up for consideration.

As an abundant caution, this Court before finalising the scheme of administration solicits further suggestions from the Committee of Management in place. The committee of management shall affix the complete scheme of administration at a conspicuous place within the precincts of temple so that the devotees may go through the same and propose any valuable suggestions whatsoever and drop in the box placed at an appropriate place adjacent or near to the place where the scheme is affixed. All suggestions received in the box shall be scrutinized by the Committee of Management and any valuable suggestion proposed for effective management of the trust be reported to this Court and a copy thereof may be exchanged between the parties appearing here in this

proceeding.

This exercise shall be completed not later than a period of one month.
